This year I continue to balance my time in the studio with teaching at the Royal West of England Academy, where I currently have a piece on display in the Annual Open Exhibition.

Unfortunately, on the evening of the Private View last Friday, an underground electrical fire broke out across the road from the RWA. The building had to be evacuated just moments before the event was due to open. With over 600 artworks at risk, there was understandable concern among the organisers. Thankfully, the fire was quickly brought under control, but the cancellation of such an important evening was a huge disappointment for everyone involved. The exhibition—Bristol's equivalent to the Royal Academy Summer Show—remains open until 28th December, and I'm pleased that my painting The Thekla is on display there.





Some of you may remember the portrait of my great-grandparents, which hung for nearly 20 years in the Gurnard's Head Hotel near St Ives, Cornwall. The painting attracted considerable interest, led to many portrait commissions, and brought me countless kind comments for which I remain very grateful. It has now found a wonderful new home in London.
